



Angle meter

For ski edges or snowboard edges

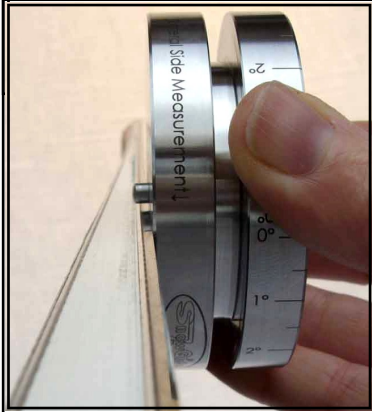
MADE IN FRANCE

before measurement, check the flatness of the base

Lateral angle measurement:

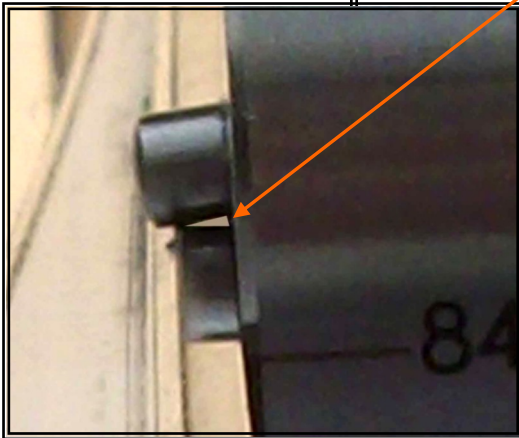

Place the ski on side, and make light reflect on the edge.
Put the tool plan marked "Lateral side measurement" on the ski's base



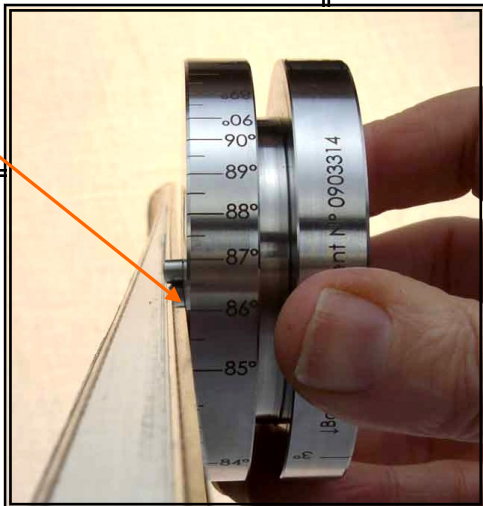

Put the pawn on the edge, and rotate the disk to get the 84° digit up side up.
By using the light reflection, highlight the triangle shape



Rotate the disk until the triangle disappear.
When the pawn is in perfect contact with the edge, read the digit in front of the edge.

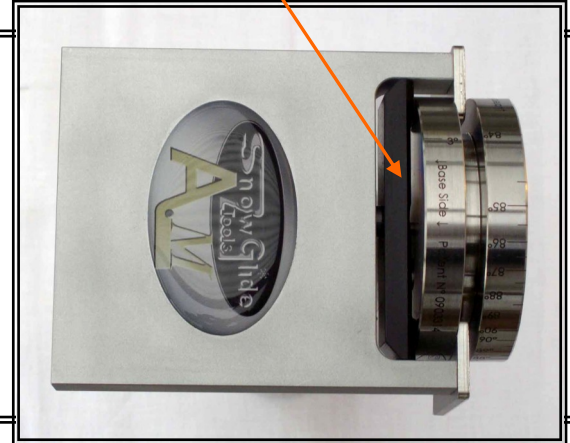

Base side angle measurement:

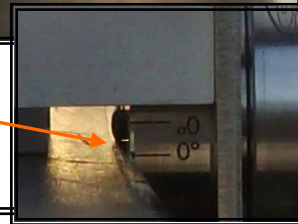
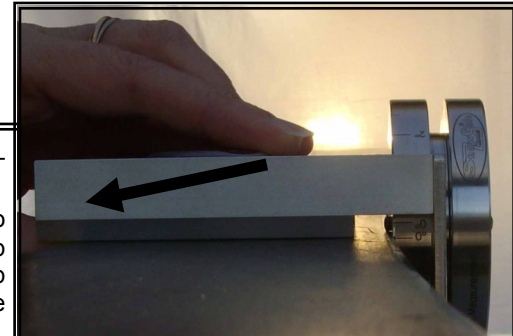
Insert the disk into the support, "base side" near the plastic the part with springs.



Place the ski base up in vices and light the edge to make it shine.

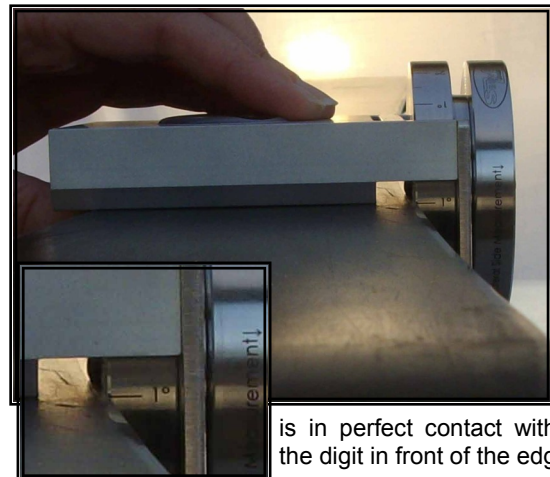

Maintain the support on the base
Rotate the disk to get the 0° digit up side up and drop the pawn on the base
By using the light reflection, highlight the triangle shape

Rotate the disk until the pawn fully tangent the edge



When the pawn is in perfect contact with the edge, read the digit in front of the edge.
